How I came to know and love Veronica and Ralph is through our Catholic organization called the Disciples of Mercy. Veronica embraced whole heartedly one of the last missions in life entrusted to her by the Lord: that was to spread the messages of Divine Mercy that were given by Jesus and the Blessed Mother to a lady named Lori G. Now, what could Veronica possibly have in common with a woman who was Jewish, and converted to become a Catholic? She said yes to the Lord.

Now I don't have a crucifix with the hands of Jesus missing from the Crucifix ... but I am not Veronica. There are now more than 23 Disciples of Mercy groups that she created and nurtured in Peru, teaching them about God's mercy by teaching how we are His hands of mercy to thousands of the poor in body and spirit.

I cannot teach the messages of Divine Mercy that Jesus shares in the Heart of God in such a way as to attract more than 300 new Spanish Disciples of Mercy to embrace the Lord's messages... but then I am not Veronica.

I am not eloquent... but then I am not Veronica— she wrote letters to the Disciples of Mercy in Peru, kind of like St Paul. Beautiful, poetic letters, full of wisdom and spiritual teaching. She titled them "Whisperings".

Whisper...not hardly...I don't have a voice like an angel when I sing..but then I am not Veronica.
It was at the Disciples of Mercy Conference in Lima in 2014, when we heard Veronica sing "Climb every mountain" from Sound of Music. You could say she herself was like that benevolent, wise compassionate Mother Superior in the movie— in fact, I consider Veronica my spiritual mother. "Follow every rainbow... until you find your dream".
Once again her connection with the lady who received the Messages from the Lord, who would seek rainbows from Jesus as her intimate connection with her Lord.

Speaking of intimate connection with the Lord, I had the privilege of sharing a bedroom with Veronica on a trip to Conyers Georgia where because of her magnetism, we were able to start another Disciple of Mercy prayer group. I don't speak in tongues during my sleep, or joke with my angels while I go to sleep at night... but then I am not Veronica.

Again, Veronica brought the messages of the Heart of God into the prisons in Lima, when she took some of our Disciples with her into the high security prison. There under her guidance, we prayed with the prisoners, as she helped us do with the drug Rehab center. I didn't touch the faces of those spiritually and emotionally hungry souls, bringing tears of cleansing to their eyes and healing to their bodies and souls... but I am not Veronica.

And what about her passion for life? I have not distributed in Peru hundreds of the messages in the Heart of God about the devastation of abortion... but I am not Veronica.

I close with one of the very messages that Veronica read with her Disciples– It was dictated by the Blessed Mother on May 10, 1996: "Children, for one to truly be my Son's disciple, he must learn to accept the thorns as well as the roses. He must learn that at some dinners only clear broth will be served, and at other dinners bowls of delicious stew will be served."

Children, when you learn to embrace a bowl of clear broth the same way you would embrace a bowl of stew, then you may truly call yourselves disciples of the Holy One, for did not my Son embrace the manger, thereby placing great value on the virtue of humility?"

Oh yes, I am not Veronica.
